As part of our enjoyment and celebration of reading we are planning a 'Bring and Share a Story' Family event in which children and a family member will be able to bring a favourite story into class to read to a small group of children. This will take place on Friday 18th November. There will be a morning session from 9-9.30am and an afternoon session from 2.30-3.00pm.
