

Felt Hanging: In this Monday's assembly the staff and children gathered in anticipation for the 'great reveal' of the felt picture that Frome Felt artist Bessie has helped them to create to adorn the front wall of the School Hall. There was a spontaneous cheer as the beautiful hanging was revealed. Bessie started working with the school in January 2017. Each child had a chance to create a small sampler to learn the technique then Bessie assembled the plan and every child made a creature which when put together created the picture. Do take the opportunity to visit the School Hall with your child at some point to see their work. As part of the Frome Festival programme under Venue 4 will find Bessie's studio and you can see the photos of the project as it progressed over the months.
