

Frome Missing Links Event: We will be taking part in this event all next week when families are being encouraged to walk, scoot and bike to school either the whole way or part of the journey. We will be logging our results on the Sustrans website. On Monday morning (22nd May) there will be healthy snacks and a smoothie bike for pupils to enjoy from 8.30am after their active journey to school. This will be in the Games Court or if it is raining will move to under the canopy of the KS1 playground. On Friday 26th May we will have a mufti day when contributions will be collected in aid of the Frome Missing Links project which aims to complete the Frome to Radstock cycle route. On this day children can come dressed in their own clothes and decorate their shoes or scooters as part of the fun.

Whole school sponsored Sports Day and Family Picnic on Thursday 22nd June: We are planning a sponsored Colour Fun Run in aid of our main playground development. This will be a whole family event when we will encourage you and your children to dress in bright colours and run as many laps of the school field or cheer on your child as they run as many laps as they can. We have received quotes for installing an all-weather surface to two thirds of our grassed area which will increase the play space available all year round. We already have some of the cost covered through use of our Sports Premium Grant and money the VSA have already raised but we will need to raise a further £7,000 and we hope our sponsored event and VSA School Fair will help towards reaching the total. After last year's success we will once again return to the school grounds for a Family Picnic. This event will rely on good weather and if it is rained off we will try to carry out the run on the Friday 23rd June but we will not be able to reschedule the picnic as it disrupts our Catering Company's arrangements.
