**School Budgets:** You will have heard a great deal in the news about cuts to school budgets and the impact on staffing and resources. Frome schools have also been affected. Thanks to careful spending over the last few years the school is well resourced and in good order. At our recent Governors' Finance Meeting the Governors received a report on our budget which is being well spent to maximise benefits to the children. The Governors agreed to maintain our current school structure of 10 classes for next academic year 2017-2018. We have also had news that we have been granted additional funds from Somerset County Council's Capital Fund for works to the school building which will take place over the next two years. The Frome Learning Partnership work closely together and attract considerable additional funding as a result of this partnership, which we use to support all our children and families, enhance curriculum opportunities and train staff.

**Frome Missing Links:** On Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> June, Marjory Hatvany will be coming to talk to our children about the Frome Missing Links project and update them on the progress made with raising funds for the cycle path. Some of our children have won prizes in the competitions and we will find out who has won. We will announce the winners in the next newsletter.
