



Christmas Performances: The children will be performing their Christmas plays during the week beginning 12th December. Due to the large numbers of children in KS1 who need to be given a part in the play and the large numbers of parents who want to come and watch, we will be performing two plays each session in KS1 Year groups. See below for dates and times for your child's performance. You will need to collect tickets for entry to watch the plays as this allows us to manage audience numbers at each performance. In the first instance we allocate two tickets to each child. Any remaining tickets are then made available on the day on a first come first served basis. Prams will need to be parked in the Key Stage One playground. There will be a retiring collection after each performance.
