**School Travel Challenge**: Today we had a school assembly to launch the Frome Missing Links Schools' Travel challenge. This is designed to raise awareness of the aims of Frome Missing Links group which is trying to develop the cycling and walking link between Frome and Radstock and on to Bath. As part of this year's event we were thrilled to have won a bike and scooter rack which has been made by Frome's Men's Shed.

During the week 21<sup>st</sup>- 25<sup>th</sup> May children are encouraged to walk, cycle or scoot to school even if you are only able to do this for part of your journey. We will be hoping to increase the percentage of children who do this during the week compared to our usual percentage. On Monday 21<sup>st</sup> May we are hoping that any children who walk, cycle or scoot to school will be able to join us for a healthy breakfast snack at 8.30am. On Friday 25<sup>th</sup> May children will be encouraged to bring in a donation in aid of the Frome Missing Links project and they will be able to wear something to 'Be Bright and Be Seen'. This might be light coloured or fluorescent clothing which as we all know is important when walking, cycling or scooting especially when it is getting darker. We are also expecting a BMX stunt bike performance and workshop as part of this week.

After hours use of the school playground: As a result of parental requests we have permitted school families to use our school playground at the end of the school day to enable socialising and play. School staff have been very concerned recently about the lack of supervision of children using the playground. Please remind your children that they should only climb on the apparatus provided. The fences, green playpods and target boards are not part of our climbing equipment and the children are not allowed to use them in school time. Please ensure bikes and scooters are not used in the playground as much younger children are using this space after school. Ball games such as football can be played on the games court which can be accessed from the top gate. The joining gate is currently locked so that tyres can only be rolled on the flat games court which is where they are used during the school day. Please encourage your children to use this space respectfully so that the playground remains open. **School trips:** During the Summer term we usually plan school trips to places out of Frome. This year KS2 will be visiting the Roman Baths and EYFS are hoping to go to the seaside. KS1 are still planning their trip. You may want to start putting aside some money as most of our trips rely on sponsorship from our VSA and parental contributions to make them viable as the school budget cannot subsidise them.
