When you get into your classroom there will be an adult to welcome you and help you come into school and wash your hands.



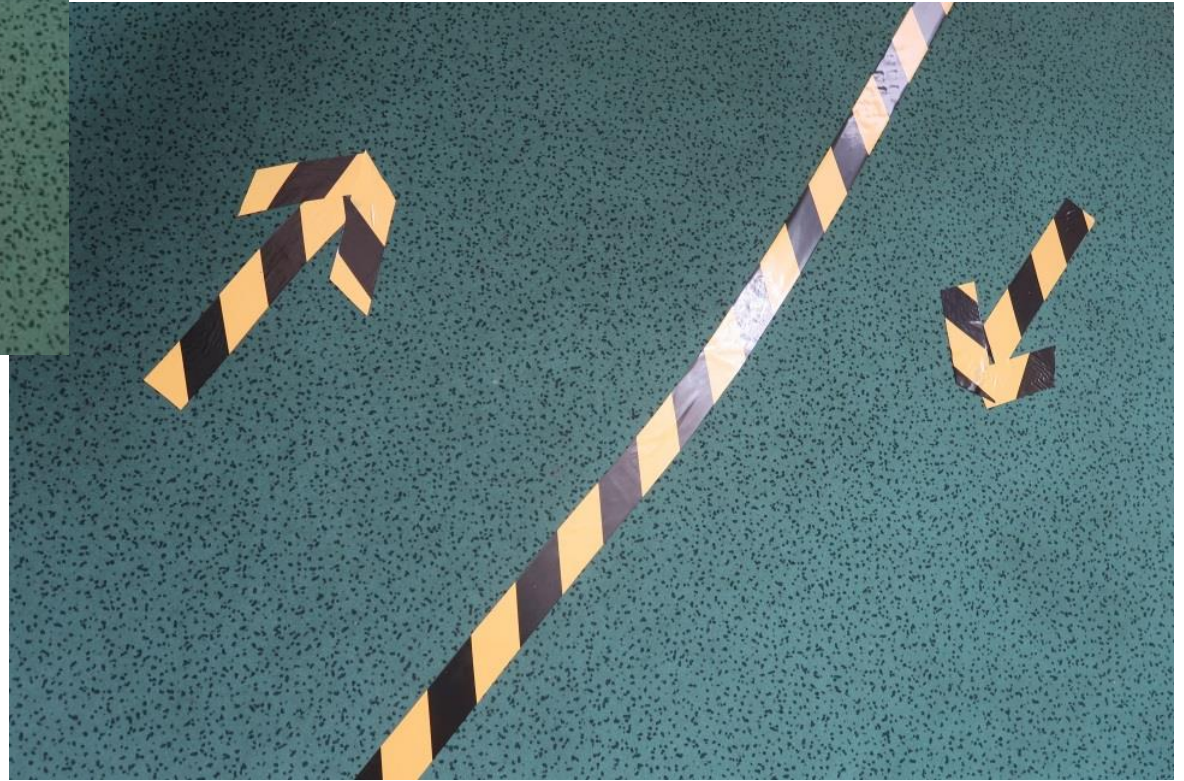
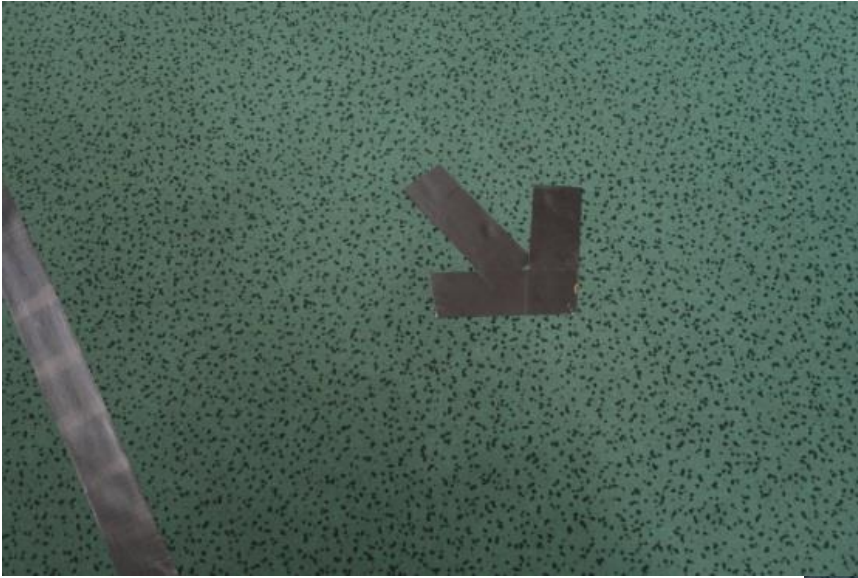


Some adults might be wearing special masks and aprons.

You have to stay inside your class bubble unless an adult asks you to go to a different space.

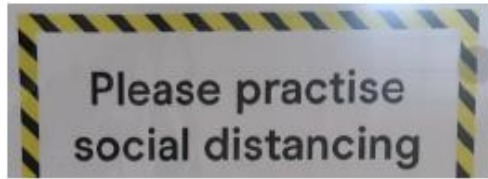
You can leave your bubble to go to the toilet.





Your class bubble will have an outdoor space to take turns to use.

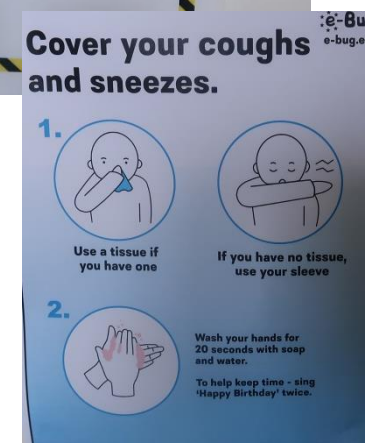
You're not allowed to touch others or hug at the moment.
