

# VALLIS SCHOOL ASSOCIATION (VSA)

## HUNDRED CLUB

### **What is it?**

A bit like a lottery, members of the VSA (parents/carers and school staff) purchase a number to be entered into a monthly draw. The aim of the club is to raise additional funds for Vallis First School VSA.

### **How much does it cost?**

Members can buy up to three numbers by 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020 which will be entered into monthly draws starting 19<sup>th</sup> October 2020. The cost of entering one number in all ten draws will be £10.00, two numbers £20.00 and three numbers £30.00.

### **How much could I win?**

50% of the lottery fund will be paid out as prize money. Therefore, if 100 tickets are purchased, the 1<sup>st</sup> prize will be £25, the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize £15 and the 3<sup>rd</sup> prize £10 each month, but it will depend on how many numbers are purchased during the sign up period. The final prize fund available will be published once the subscription period has ended on 7<sup>th</sup> October.

### **What if you do not have enough interest?**

If not enough people have joined by 7<sup>th</sup> October, the club will not take place and any monies received already will be returned.

### **When will the draws take place?**

The first draw will take place on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October. From November 2020 to July 2021 the draws will take place on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month virtually using an internet random number generator.

### **How will I know if I have won?**

You will be contacted directly using the details provided on the membership form. Winners will also be announced on the VSA Facebook page and school newsletter if you have given your consent. Prizes will be available by BACS, Paypal or in cash collected from the school office.

### **What happens to the other 50% of the money raised?**

The remaining 50% of the fund will go to the VSA to contribute towards the improvement to the school playground, and any other school activities for which the school request contributions from the VSA.

### **How do I join?**

Please read the rules of the Hundred Club overleaf, and if you would like to join, please complete the attached application form and return it, along with your payment, to the VSA Committee, either in photo form by email to [vallisvsa@gmail.com](mailto:vallisvsa@gmail.com) or in hard copy care of the School Office by **7<sup>th</sup> October 2020**.

### **VSA Hundred Club Rules**

1. The Hundred Club (The Club) exists to raise funds for Vallis First School and will run from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020 – 31<sup>st</sup> July 2021. The Club is open to any member of the Vallis First School PTA, (known as the VSA) over the age of 18 years who has filled in an application form. (Any parent/carer of a child at the school is automatically a member of the VSA).
2. The subscription to the Club for this trial shall be ten pounds (£10.00) per number (up to a maximum of 3 numbers) payable by BACS (details on request), cash or cheque, made payable to The Vallis School Association.
3. The October draw shall take place on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2020. Thereafter draws shall be held on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month in November 2020 – July 2021.
4. A subscription for which payment has been made by BACS, cash or cheque by 7<sup>th</sup> October in accordance with Rule 3 above, shall entitle the registered member to take part.
5. The prize fund shall be of a total value not less than 50% of the total annual subscriptions. Final fund amounts will be published once the sign up period has ended on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020.
6. Prizes will be available by BACS, Paypal or in cash by collection from the School Office as soon as possible after the draw.
7. Individuals who have won will be contacted using the details provided when joining and will also be published on the VSA Facebook page and school newsletter.
8. It is the responsibility of the member to advise the organiser of any change of contact details.
9. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into VSA funds after 6 months.
10. Any surplus from the Club will be used by the Vallis School Association for the benefit of the school.
11. The decision of the VSA committee shall be final and binding in any dispute between a member and the organiser.
12. The Club is run as a private lottery in accordance with the Gambling Act 2005.
13. Application for membership shall be deemed as acceptance of the Club rules.
14. The VSA committee may amend the rules of the Club at any time. Members will be informed of changes by letter or email.
15. Should there be insufficient interest to run the trial, all monies received by 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020 will be returned to the subscriber.
16. These rules were approved at a meeting of the VSA Committee on 17/01/2018 and updated to reflect the 2020/21 academic year on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020.
