They are open for browsing and for accessing public network computers over the holidays for much of the time and usually they're not so busy, so staff should have a bit of time to chat. Our 'Library Choice' service has proved to be very popular (whereby staff can hand-pick a selection of books for people to try, based on their reading preferences) so we are still keen to promote this as well as simply popping in to your local library and 'trying something different'.
