Based at Frome Town Hall, the Frome Learning Partnership (FLP) have a vacancy for a **Medical Tutor** who will travel to schools/pupil homes to provide high quality teaching and learning in 1:1 and/or small group environments to KS3/KS4 pupils who have been referred to Medical Tuition. The successful candidate work in partnership with schools and other agencies to deliver a bespoke and individualised KS3/KS4 curriculum to pupils outside of their school environment, including their homes, online etc. supporting pupils with reintegration back to school.

## The successful candidate will have:

- Experience of working with young people
- Knowledge and experience of the National Curriculum
- Able to analyse student data information to create IEPs/set targets
- Ability to communicate effectively with pupils and build positive relationships
- Flexibility in responding to needs of the pupils
- Form and maintain good working relationships with school and agency colleagues
- Good working knowledge of Microsoft office
- Able to work independently with strong organisation and co-ordination skills

FLP is comprised of 11 first schools, 2 primary school, 2 middle schools, 1 KS1 to KS3, 1 special school, and Frome College, including over 4,500 children and young people. FLP has statutory responsibility; delegated by Somerset County Council (SCC), to provide Alternative Provision and Early Help support, including Medical Tuition, to pupils and families based in Frome and the surrounding villages.
