Message from our Headteacher

Welcome back to a new term and a new year. I hope you all had a great Christmas break with your families and you are all looking forward to the year ahead.

Although it has been a short week this week, we have been very busy in school. The Nest, which is where our nurture groups learn and also some 1:1 interventions take place, has been moved to Kingfisher classroom (the old Jupiter). The space is bigger and far more suitable for the children and as they settle in there, we hope to develop it further.

There are a number of things that we are working on at the moment in school which I would like to tell you about:

- The office is in the process of setting up parent pay which is an electronic payment system meaning that there is an alternative to cash. The team are just going through the onboarding and training process and then will be in touch as soon as possible with details to help you set up your parent accounts.
- We also met with representatives from Cosmic Monkey in the week before Christmas and by the end of January they will be our preferred supplier for all our logo uniform items, as well as a one stop shop for non branded items like PE kit. Cosmic Monkey is a local company who work with many of the schools in the town already and offer the chance for you to pick up uniform all year round, including during the school holidays. Once they are set up in terms of our page on their website we will send out more information.
- Those of you who have had children at the school for a couple of years will know that we carry out a review of the data we hold for children each academic year to make sure it is correct and current—information like emergency contact names, numbers, addresses etc. Previously we have sent home paper copies of the data but this year we will be trialling the SIMS Parent App Lite to do this (this is a free add-on to our internal people management system which some of you may have had experience of through the Middle Schools). Again, this will involve setting you up with a parent account on the SIMS App, but in terms of data security and reducing the amount of paper we use, as well as making the process more efficient, we feel this will be a positive step forward. The ladies in the office will be in touch with information on how to sign up to the app once all the setting up is complete.
- For some time, we have been looking into a class communication system along the lines of ClassDojo which some of you may be familiar with. There are a lot of options out there so if you have had experience of any systems good or bad please let the office know so we can try and make an informed decision on the best one for Vallis.

Along with the VSA, I am looking into further developing the outside area of the school with possible new equipment. If you have any thoughts or ideas as to what you think would work well, please let the school or a member of the VSA know.

We have another busy term ahead of us but as always, if there is anything you are not sure about, ideas you would like to suggest or any concerns/queries, please let the office know.
