Vallis Book Week 'The Joy of Reading' - Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November to Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2017: Book Fair: During our Book Week the Book Fair will arrive on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November and leave a week later on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> November. A range of lovely children's books will be on sale each day in our School Hall for a week with the school receiving 'benefits in kind' in the form of books for our class book corners. Please support our Book Fair - the more books we sell the more books we get for the classes!

Bedtime story afternoon: As part of Book Week we will be holding a special Bedtime story afternoon on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November. Children are invited to bring a cuddly toy to school, pyjamas, slippers or a dressing gown to change in to after lunchtime play, ready to snuggle down for an afternoon of storytelling courtesy of the Vallis First School staff. We would like to ask parents to send in a donation towards the cost of upgrading our class book corners which the children will design as part of their Book Fair activities. The VSA are kindly providing the refreshments just to make everything extra special! During the week we will also be designing a display for the Hall or Library of our favourite books.

Book Week Photo Competition: Parents should take a photo of their child reading their book in their favourite place! Submitted photos will be enlarged to display around the classes, Hall and Library so please do not enter if you do not want your child's photo displayed around the school. The winner in each Key Stage will be given a voucher to spend at the Book Fair!

Frome Learning Partnership (FLP) Writing Competition: Over the half term our children will be preparing their entries for the FLP writing competition. They will create, write and illustrate their entries which will be judged by a panel of local dignitaries and prizes awarded. We are hoping that we may be able to publish a pamphlet of the winning entries across the Frome schools. As part of the FLP Word up writing project organised by Lisa Millard some of our Y4s will have the chance to take part in a 5 day 'Author in Residence' writing workshop. They will then share their learning with their class mates. Even the teachers have been involved in writing as part of a twilight programme. Great to see their creative talents shine!
