Parking around the school site: In order to keep our children and families safe we restrict the movement of traffic at the beginning and end of the school day by locking our car park gate and putting out traffic cones to stop cars entering the Milk Street. For the benefit of new parents to the school and others who may not be aware please do not park in the school car park or on the road near the School Crossing Patrols because this area needs to be free so that our Crossing Patrol people can see to cross children safely. There is plenty of parking in the streets around the neighbourhood but please be courteous to our neighbours. Parking on corners is of course illegal and endangers other road users and may result in a ticket. Please ensure you model good road safety by using the Crossing Patrol outside our school or outside St Louis' school and stick to the paths into school rather than crossing the car park.

School funding and Benefit Based Free School

Meals: All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to Universal Free School Meals. If you are receiving Income Support, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance or Income-related Employment and Support Allowance please come to the School Office and we can register your child. This attracts additional funding for the school and entitles children to half price trips and clubs.

Flu Vaccination: Your child will have come home with a consent form for the Flu Vaccination. The Vaccination is due to take place on Tuesday 2nd October in the morning. Please ensure that the consent form is filled in and handed back to the School Office to ensure that your child receives this vaccination.

Clubs: We have 2 places on Dodgeball (Thursday's) and 1 place on Tag Rugby (Wednesday's). If you would like your child to have one of these places, please come to the School Office to book and pay for their place.
