

This final half term we will continue our Seasonal Changes topic

Personal Social and Emotional Development

During circle time the children will share their experiences of the summer or favourite places to visit during the summer.

Communication and Language

The children will take it in turns to find summer themed objects hidden in sand and encouraged to describe what the objects feel like to a friend without looking at the object.

Physical Development

The children will continue to improve their fine and gross motor skills. They will develop their bat and ball skills during PE. They will also be practising for their first Sports Day!

Literacy

The children will continue to develop their reading and comprehension skills through our Reading Scheme. They will write a recount of their trip to Bath City Farm and write a thank you letter to the staff.

Maths

The children will learn about doubles up to 10 as well as halving and sharing equally. They will be learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. They will also use buckets, bottles and other containers to estimate size, weight and capacity.

Understanding the World

They will think about the changes that have happened in their local area since they started school in September. They will visit Bath City Farm where they will have the opportunity to learn about and meet the animals, they will also be challenged to look for various objects during a nature walk.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will use the materials of their choice to make instruments for a beach band and a puppet theatre and create a seaside themed role play area.
