Summer Reading Challenge at Frome Library: Don't forget to get involved in this year's Libraries Reading Challenge. Just visit our local Frome Library to sign up. This year the Challenge is called Space Race, inspired by the 50th anniversary of the first moon landing. Children taking part in the Challenge will join the super space family, the Rockets, for a thrilling mission to track down books nabbed by mischievous aliens. There will be the usual (often smelly) stickers to collect and clues to solve. Children who take part are encouraged to read up to 6 books, either on their own or with family. Books can be fiction, non-fiction, graphic or audio. There is a certificate for every child that takes part, those who read 6 books get a medal as well, all of which will be presented during a school assembly in the Autumn term. The Library also runs a number of activities based around the Challenge theme.
