Use the numbers you find to make your own superhero countdown. Can you put them in order?</p>	<p>Do 3 super kind things for your family and be a Superhero helper. You might do the hoovering, help cook tea, lay the table or read a book to a younger brother or sister.</p>
<p>Make up a rap/song about your superhero. Maybe you could use things around your home as percussion to keep the beat. It might go like this:</p> <p>I'm a superhero. I'm the best. I can fly higher than all the rest!</p>	<p>When you have read your book make some puppets to retell your story.
