Reading-During our phone calls over the holidays parents have asked about reading books. There is free access to Oxford Owl ebooks which are the phonics books that children will be familiar with. You just need to register as a parent. To access the correct books click the 'level' tab and then 'book band'. Your child can then find the correct colour they are reading at home (or even from the one above like we do in guided reading). EYFS children click on 'level' then choose 'Letters and Sounds' Phases 3 or 4.
