Classrooms hygiene protocols (for classrooms in use)

Each classroom will be supplied with liquid soap in wall dispensers, paper towels and a lined bin. This is to ensure your pupils have constant access to the above as per Government guidelines for regular handwashing. Children should wash their hands thoroughly and regularly starting when they arrive at school, after playtimes, before they eat lunch and before they leave school as a minimum requirement. Stocks of the above items will be checked and replenished daily by the cleaning team, and the bins will be emptied on a daily basis.

Classrooms will also be given spray disinfectant in a marked bottle (this is a hospital grade disinfectant), and a roll of paper towel – these are to be used regularly throughout the day to sanitise desk tops, taps, door handles, chairs etc. Again, these levels will be checked and replenished daily by the cleaning team.

Each classroom will have a bottle of hand sanitiser in case access to soap and water is unavailable, ie. in the playgrounds.

Each cohort will also be given a PPE kit should a befitting first aid issue arise. Each cohort will also be given an aerosol sanitiser which should be used regularly on toilet seats, flush handle, taps and door handles etc in the toilet/s that your cohort are using.

Please can all hard surfaces such as desks and sink surrounds be kept clear to enable easy access for sanitisation.
