<p>Find out about famous pirates from history. You could</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• create a leaflet• make a powerpoint• make a 'wanted' poster 	<p>You have found an ancient map... perhaps it leads to treasure.</p> <p>Make the map that will lead you to it.</p> <p>Think about the geographical features that you might include on your map. Is it an island? Are there rivers, mountains or swamps that you need to put onto the map?</p>	<p>Make your own comic strip or story of your pirate's adventures!</p> 	<p>Find out how to play Battleships (Pirate Ships??). Using coordinates and play with somebody you live with.</p> <p>Try and draw your own grids and see how many ships you can sink.</p>
<p>Use your imagination to create pirate character. Is it a boy or a girl; a man or a woman? What will they wear? How will they look? You could draw, paint, or even dress up as your character.</p>			
<p>Make something! It could be a pirate ship, cannon or something else that a pirate might need.</p> 	<p>Do you have your own collection of special things?</p> <p>Find or make a small box and fill it with treasures of own.</p>	<p>Imagine that you are stranded on a treasure island.</p> <p>Write a message to send in a bottle asking for help.</p> <p>How will the person who finds your message know how to find you?</p>	<p>Find or make up some pirate jokes and post them on Virtual Vallis.</p> <p>We would love to see you telling your jokes in a video.</p>
