<u>Curriculum Overview – Key Stage 2</u> <u>Spring Term 2022</u>

Our topic this term is 'The Ice Palace'. During this topic we will be focussing on climate and depictions of cold climates in a variety of works of art. We will also be learning about magnets and forces in science. Violins will now held for Milky Way class, Galaxy will be swimming as well as remaining Y4s having their brass music tuition.

<u>English</u>

In English, the children will be studying *The Ice Palace* by Robert Swindles. They will be writing their own stories, poems, notes and sets of instructions based around this text. The children will be learning to use interesting words to improve their writing, how different types of text are structured and punctuated and think about the different purposes for writing. Children will deepen their understanding of texts through discussion and drama.

<u>Maths</u>

The main focus in Maths this term is multiplication and division. Children will learn a variety of ways of solving calculations and applying their knowledge to solve maths problems. In Y4 the children will also learn about area and perimeter, fractions and decimals. The Y3 children will also learn about money, statistics, length and perimeter. They will continue rehearsing their times tables.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be learning about staying safe. We will discuss who keeps us safe, the difference between danger and risk, e-safety. There will also be a 'light touch' introduction to risks associated with smoking and alcohol. We will think about how we keep healthy and what we can do that will help or harm our health.

<u>Computing</u>

Throughout the spring term, the children will be learning about programming and will have a session on esafety.
