Lunch bookings

Remember that all lunch bookings, even for children in EYFS and KS1 who have Universal Infant Free School Meals and children in KS2 who are entitled to Benefit Based Free School meals, must be booked using ParentPay now. It is really important that lunches are ordered 7 days before the start of the week you want to book for. For week commencing 3rd June, you need to book these by next Tuesday evening please so we can order before the half term. Some parents/carers have said that they can't book for Monday 3rd June onwards, but please click on Tuesday 4th June onwards as Monday 3rd June is an INSET day.

If you miss the deadline to book the week's meals please speak to the office to agree a way forward as Selwood Kitchen cannot accept late orders. After half term, if you miss the deadline to book melas you will need to supply a packed lunch for your child for that week.

If you still haven't activated your account please do so ASAP. If you need another copy of your activation letter please let the office team know.
