Lunch bookings

Remember that all lunch bookings, even for children in EYFS and KS1 who are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals and children in KS2 who are entitled to Benefit Based Free School meals, must be booked using ParentPay now. It is really important that lunches are ordered 7 days before the start of the week you want to book for. For week commencing 17th June, you need to book these by this Sunday evening please so we can order in accordance with the Selwood Kitchens ordering policy . If you miss the deadline to book the week's meals please speak to the office to agree a way forward as Selwood Kitchen cannot accept late orders.

If you still haven't activated your account please do so ASAP. If you need another copy of your activation letter please let the office team know.
